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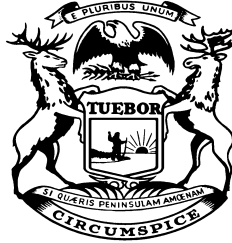
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NOTICE OF AUTOMATIC SUSPENSION FOR NON-PAYMENT OF COSTS

On July 15, 2026, an Amended Order of Suspension was issued by the Attorney Discipline Board in *Grievance Administrator v Donald J Cataldo*, 24-30-GA, suspending respondent's license to practice law for 30 days. Pursuant to that order, respondent was ordered to pay \$5,403.56 in assessed costs on or before August 4, 2026.¹ On August 17, 2026, the Attorney Discipline Board served a certified report on respondent, and with the State Bar of Michigan, showing that respondent had failed to reimburse the Attorney Discipline System for the expenses of the above-entitled disciplinary action within the time prescribed.

In accordance with MCR 9.128(D), respondent's license to practice law in Michigan was automatically suspended, effective August 25, 2026. The suspension will remain in effect until the costs have been paid or the Attorney Discipline Board approves a suitable plan for payment, and until respondent complies with MCR 9.119 and 9.123(A).

¹ On July 15, 2026, respondent filed a motion with the hearing panel seeking modification of the effective date of his suspension to September 1, 2026. The hearing panel granted respondent's motion. However, neither respondent's motion nor the hearing panel's order modified the date for the payment of costs, which remained August 4, 2026.
