ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT

On April 27, 2026, Grand Traverse County Hearing Panel #1 entered an Order of Suspension (By Consent) in this matter suspending respondent from the practice of law in Michigan for 30 days, effective July 1, 2026. On August 3, 2026, respondent filed an affidavit titled Affidavit of Full and Continuing Compliance. Respondent's affidavit did not indicate whether it was filed pursuant to MCR 9.119 or MCR 9.123, thus he was asked to clarify his affidavit. On August 5, 2026, respondent advised the Board that his August 3, 2026, affidavit was filed pursuant to MCR 9.123(A). On August 10, 2026, the Grievance Administrator filed an objection to respondent's reinstatement noting that respondent had not yet complied with the requirements of MCR 9.119(C). On August 13, 2026, respondent filed a second affidavit noting that it was filed pursuant to MCR 9.119 and MCR 9.123(A). Respondent's affidavit states that he has fully complied with all requirements of the Order of Suspension (By Consent) and that he will continue to comply with the order until and unless he is reinstated. On August 21, 2026, the Grievance Administrator withdrew the objection to respondent's reinstatement noting that the Administrator is now satisfied with respondent's affidavit; and the Board being otherwise advised;

NOW THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED that respondent, John E. Berry, P 34268, is **REINSTATED** to the practice of law in Michigan, effective **August 24, 2026**.
